The role

The role of the Demand Planner requires a highly meticulous, commercially rounded, organised planner, to take immediate ownership of sales planning activities.

Reporting directly to the Sales Operation Manager, this role carries a significant degree of authority, autonomy and planning, as you become responsible for the smooth daily planning of sales. Working closely with the territory managers and account managers, you shall monitor and orchestrate weekly order books, balancing market demand with production capacity and organisational budgeted targets. Accordingly, your work requires tight, cross functional collaboration with Sales department and operations department, with close collaboration with Supply Planning and Production Planning. Being capable of building and maintaining effective and trusting relationships is therefore paramount in this pivotal position.

Brompton operates a lean manufacturing policy and bikes are produced to order, all year round. There is vast reliance upon suppliers to deliver parts on time. You must work closely with Supply Chain to provide reliable forecasting on special editions, critical options and parts and accessories.

While we are implementing the ERP, you will need to be able to evolve with our new systems, by building and following excel planning tool and testing our ERP environment to feedback any requested improvement. Therefore, Problem solving and continuous improvement shall be key feature of your role.

This is a role for someone who wants to roll their sleeves up and get stuck in. You will be the go to person in the Department and the right hand of the Sales Operations Manager. It is a role for someone who is keen to learn the full breadth of our company's activities and products, who is ready to progress in a role they are already sure-footed in, and who is excited by the potential of a long-term commitment to this fast-growing British success story.

 - Working with data, customers, sales team and Supply Chain to improve forecast accuracy

 - Ensuring Scheduling of demand and manufacturing supply is maintained in in-line with customer demand and in accordance with budget, to improve our efficiency

 - Maintain and improve Sales and Operations planning process of bikes and Parts and accessories with Supply Chain.
 - Coordinating new product and product phase out planning with stakeholders
- Others
 - Participating to daily operations meeting, providing feedback regarding global demand.
 - Preparing a variety of status reports in Excel and Word
 - Testing and contributing to constant development of current and new systems.
